



NAME OF THE WINE: CORTESE COLLI TORTONESI

Classification: Cortese Colli Tortonesi DOC

Variety: 100% Cortese

Altitude: 300 meters above sea level

Yield per hectare: 6 tons

System of growing: Guyot

Vine density: 6000 vines per hectare

Aging: 8 months in steel tanks and a minimum of 3 months aging in the bottle

Type of soil: limestone, clay

Time of harvest: third week of September

Average age of vines: 40 years

Description: The color is straw-yellow with green highlights. The nose is complex, with suggestions of white flowers and Moscato.

The mouthfeel is full and rich, the crispness makes it drinkable and long.
