



## NAME OF THE WINE: ROSSO COLLI TORTONESI

**Classification:** Rosso Colli Tortonesi DOC

**Variety:** 90% Barbera, 10% Dolcetto

**Altitude:** 300 meters above sea level

**Yield per hectare:** 7 tons

**System of growing:** Guyot

**Vine density:** 6000 vines per hectare

**Aging:** 8 months in concrete tanks and a minimum of 3 months aging in the bottle

**Type of soil:** limestone, clay

**Time of harvest:** third week of September – first week of October

**Average age of vines:** 40 years

**Description:** The color is deep red.

The bouquet is composed of red fruits, maquis and spices.

The mouthfeel is structured, firm and crisp which is typical of Barbera
